I recently heard about your organization on TV. My father, who was a Navy veteran of WWII and Korea, passed away in September. He had some medical aids that I'm wondering if you could use for the disabled veterans. Specifically, he had a motorized chair that he received from the VA Hospital in Las Vegas. I have checked with them about returning it so another veteran could benefit. I was informed that they do not accept returned equipment; that it could be sold or donated. It's only about 2 1/2 years old and a top of the line motorized chair. I also have the lift that would be required to transport the chair. I have a couple of walkers as well; one has a seat if the user tires and needs to sit down. Do you think you could use this equipment? If not, do you know of any other organization that would take them? I'd really like a disabled veteran to be able to have this, if possible. I suppose I could sell it but, I want it to go to someone who could really use it to gain some independence again. Thank you for your attention.
